- **Treasurer's Report** – Sarah Buttera
 - PTO Balance - \$16907 including below
 - Road Runner Balance - \$2124
 - Husky Challenge - \$106
 - Garden Balance - \$2238
- **PTO Dues** – Sarah Buttera
 - Update on amount per class and distribution
 - \$2,925 Collected – doing during conferences helped, enrollment is higher this year this year as well.
 - Teachers will get the money and will ask parents if they want help – money will not go to parents - \$100 per classroom, plus \$40 for Lincoln Leader – total \$3,780 - APPROVED
- **Principal's Report** – Mary Hawkins
 - 549 Students – largest elementary in district
 - lunch and pickup/drop-off has been the biggest hurdles
